## **MEMBERSHIP**

Why join the National Model Railroad Association (NMRA)? Again this month we will continue to investigate the many reasons for joining the NMRA. This month I am going to focus on the Achievement Program (AP).

In 1960 Hal Carstens, then editor of Railroad Model Craftsman, first proposed an awards program for model railroaders. Two committees investigated the concept and a proposal for an "Achievement Awards Program" was formally adopted as an NMRA activity by the Board of Trustees at the Cleveland convention in 1961.

The AP is a system of requirements for demonstrating a superior level of skill in the various aspects of the hobby. It includes not only building various types of models, but also construction of projects in scenery, structures, track work and wiring. It also provides recognition for service to the hobby and the NMRA. The goal of the AP is to achieve the title of Master Model Railroader (MMR). There is also the Golden Spike Award which we will look at next month.

An NMRA member qualifies as a Master Model Railroader (MMR) when he/she has obtained at least seven of the eleven Achievement Certificates provided that he/she has earned at least one Achievement Certificate in each of the four areas of the Regulations. The eleven categories are: motive power, cars, structures, scenery, prototype models, civil, electrical, dispatcher, official, volunteer, and author. There are 5 requirements that are common to all categories and each category has specific requirements pertinent to that category. Space for this column does not permit a listing of all the requirements for each of the categories. I recommend that you go to www.nmra.org for complete information on the NMRA Achievement Program (AP). This program is another wonderful benefit of NMRA membership.

## January Clinics

I pm **Ingrid Drozdak** – "The Tree Lady" Ingrid will demonstrate how to make trees, bushes and other foliage for your model railroad. These techniques will work for any scale.

2 pm **John Drozdak** – "Weathering Your Rolling Stock" John will show methods on how he makes that new locomotive or piece of rolling stock look more used and aged, with his "weathering" techniques.


