MEMBERSHIP

Why join the National Model Railroad Association (NMRA)? Again this month we will continue to investigate the many reasons for joining the NMRA. Last month I explained the main focus of the NMRA Achievement Program the Master Model Railroader (MMR). This time I will provide some information on the Golden Spike Award.

The requirements for the Golden Spike Award are less challenging than those for the Master Model Railroader. The focus is on familiarity with the different aspects of model railroading rather than a high level of expertise.

There are three categories covered under the Golden Spike Award:

- I.Rolling stock (Motive Power and Cars) requirements: Display six(6) units of rolling stock (scratchbuilt, craftsman, or detailed commercial kits.
- 2. Model Railroad Setting (Structures and Scenery) requirements: Construct a minimum of eight(8) square feet of layout. Construct five(5) structures (scratch built, craftsman, or detailed commercial kits).
- 3. Engineering (Civil and Electrical) requirements: Three(3) types of trackage are required (turnout, crossing, etc). All must be properly ballasted and installed on proper roadbed. Commercial trackage may be used. All installed trackage must be properly wired so that two trains can be operated simultaneously (Double track main, single track main with sidings, block or command control etc.).

Provide one additional electrical feature such as powered turnouts, signaling, turnout indication, lighted buildings, etc.

The Golden Spike Award is a good way to started before jumping into the MMR. There is more detailed information about the Golden Spike Award on the NMRA web site Give it a look!
